

specific animals and plants discovered;

C: Original specimens of new species of animals and plants or specimens of rare animals and plants collected;

D: Indoor analysis results of specimens, samples or fossils;

E: Copies of tape and video recording materials recorded during mountaineering with attached scientific observation.

Article 22; Mountaineering groups that are permitted to conduct attached surveying and drawing activities shall provide duplication or copies of surveying and drawing results to the Surveying and Drawing Bureau of Tibet Autonomous Region through Chinese unit of the agreement.

Article 23; Without permission, foreign groups shall not conduct and scientific observation or surveying and drawing activities on route.

Chapter Four: Mountaineering Activities

Article 24; The Mountaineering Association of Tibet Autonomous Region appoints 1 – 2 members as

Liaison officers during the groups mountaineering in Tibet Autonomous Region, the responsibilities of liaison officers are as follows.

A: Assist and supervise foreign groups to obey relevant laws and regulations of the People's Republic of China;

B: Assist foreign groups to solve problems concerned during mountaineering;

C: Carry out mountaineering agreement with foreign groups;

D: Organize and manage Chinese cooperative personnels;

E: Coordinate disputes between Chinese cooperative personnels and foreign groups;

F: Control mountaineering time and examine the fact of reaching summit.

Article 25; Foreign groups shall obey following points while mountaineering in Tibet:

A: Foreign groups shall pay relevant insurances expenses for Chinese citizens in the groups;

B: Name and elevation of mountains and peaks shall be subject to the figures published by departments concerned of the People's Government of the People's Republic of China;

C: Weapons and remunerations and other forbidden goods shall not be imported to China;

D: Foreign groups shall carry out mountaineering activities strictly according to mountaineering plans approved by the physical culture and sports administrative bureau. Foreign groups shall not exchange planned mountains and peaks or routes with each other. Foreign groups shall be forbidden to climb mountains and peaks without permission;

E: Foreign groups are not allowed to cross the border during climbing the border mountains and peaks and not allowed to do the activities that damage the sovereign rights and the relationship with boundary country;

F: Foreign groups shall not accept persons who do not belong to the group to attend mountaineering activities;

G: Foreign groups shall respect customs and habits of local people;

H: If services such as transportation, board and lodging, local labor, animal transportation, etc that are not included in the plan are needed, Chinese liaison officers can arrange, all the expenses happened shall be paid to the Mountaineering Association of Tibet

Autonomous Region in accordance with relevant regulations by foreign groups;

I: Without permission from Chinese liaison officers, foreign groups shall not dismiss Chinese cooperative personnel who work for mountaineering activities or stop providing salary and insult Chinese citizens by any excuses and in any forms;

J: Foreign groups shall keep mountaineering routes and mountain areas. Foreign groups shall not place memorials and other goods in mountaineering areas without permission;

K: Foreign groups shall be forbidden to kill natural animals, damage natural plants, damage or pollute environment, collect plant seeds and nursery stocks;

L: While raising the groups national flags during mountaineering and reaching summit, a same size national flag of the People's Republic of China shall also be raised at same time;

M: Foreign groups shall submit conclusive reports to the Sports Bureau of Tibet Autonomous Region after reaching summit. The Sports Bureau of Tibet Autonomous Region shall grant certificate of reaching summit after confirming the reports;

N: Reaching summit or major casualties during

mountaineering shall be reported to the Mountaineering Association of Tibet Autonomous Region on time; If these news need to be reported, permission shall be obtained from the Sports Bureau of Tibet Autonomous Region;

O: Materials such as books, magazines, video tapes, etc about mountaineering activities shall be provided to the Sports Bureau of Tibet Autonomous Region free of charge;

P: Without permission, left goods after mountaineering shall not be sold in Tibet Autonomous Region.

Chapter Five: Punishment articles

Article 26; Foreign groups that violate laws, regulations of the People's Republic of China and relevent regulation of Tibet Autonomous Region on administration of foreigners shall be punished by departments concerned of Tibet Autonomous Region in accordance with relevent laws and regulations.

Article 27; The physical culture and sports administrative department of Tibet Autonomous Region

shall put punishment of warning and fined 5000 – 50000 Renminbi Yuan, revoking mountaineering permit, terminating mountaineering activities respectively according to violation plot on foreign groups that violate provisions of article 23 and article 25; Foreign groups shall also be confiscated all materials collected that collect specimens, samples and fossils unlawful.

Article 28; The staff members of the physical culture and sports administrative department of the People's Government of Tibet Autonomous Region and the liaison officer of the Mountaineering Association of Tibet Autonomous Region who violate the regulations, neglect of duty, take bribes and bend the laws will be punished according to the seriousness of their cases or economic sanctions; Those who violate the law will be punished according to the law.

Article 29; Party concerned shall make application for reconsideration against punishment decision according to: the administrative procedural law of the People's Republic of China and the administrative reconsiderable law of the People's Republic of China; If the party concerned fails to make application for reconsideration or litigation and perform punishment

decision, the departments that make punishment decision shall submit application to the courts for enforcement of the decision.

Chapter six: Supplementary Article

Article 30; The People's Government of Tibet Autonomous Region is responsible for the interpretation of questions arised during implemetion of the regulations.

Article 31; The regulations shall come into force upon promulgation.
